



Hello on-site day campers and families!

Sugar Creek Bible Camp is so excited that you are coming to camp this year! For generations, Sugar Creek Bible Camp has provided youth with wonderful Christian camping experiences. Youth and families need the benefits of camp now more than ever.

Please read this letter to plan for your time at camp this summer.

A HEALTH HISTORY/PERMISSION FORM must be completed. If you registered online, forms are included in the online enrollment process. You may print forms from our website, but online forms are preferred. Complete the forms and send them to Sugar Creek as soon as possible.

*Preschoolers are welcome but must be accompanied by a parent. They can do pool time and other activities as long as they are with a parent or chaperone.

Please note: All accounts should be paid in full a week prior to your camp session. Payment can be made online, or you can send a check to:

<u>Check-in:</u> When you arrive at Sugar Creek, cross the bridge, and turn right into the lower parking lot. Check-in will be on the RC Patio (covered shelter). Staff will collect any missing Registration and Health forms at this time.

Explorers

Explorer check-in begins at 9 AM at the Retreat Center (RC).

*Younger siblings in pre-school are welcome but must be accompanied by a parent. They can do pool time and other activities as long as they are with a parent or chaperone. Adults are \$10 a day. **Explorer pick-up is daily at 3 PM at the Retreat Center (RC).** There will be a short closing program at the RC at 2:45 PM, daily.

Foresters

Forester check-in begins at 8 AM at the Retreat Center (RC).

Forester pick-up is daily at 5:30 PM at the Retreat Center (RC). There will be a short closing program at the RC on Friday, ending around 5:45 PM.

LEAVE PETS AT HOME when you drop off or pick up your child.

What should you bring?

- reusable water bottle
- weather appropriate clothing
- hat, sunglasses
- swim wear, sunscreen, and towel
- sandals or water shoes that attach to the foot (no flip-flops) for creek stomping
- long pants and sturdy shoes or boots (closed toe, no Crocs) for pony/horse rides
- small backpack or cinch bag for campers to carry their belongings
- Foresters in grades 4-6 can bring a Bible or they can borrow one from camp.

What will we be doing? Activities for on-site day campers are led by our fun and caring Sugar Creek staff. Each day there will be age-appropriate activities including Bible study/story time, arts and crafts, fun games, and nature activities. Every day will also include one or more bigger activities like pony/horse rides, swimming, or creek stomping. Please bring appropriate apparel for each activity as listed above.

First Aid, Medications, Dietary Needs: Sugar Creek always has a qualified, volunteer health officer to administer First Aid. Medications must come in the original container with directions for use. All medications will be collected and dispensed by the First Aid provider, including non-prescription drugs. Inhalers are an exception. Please refer to our Health History Form for a list of OTC medications available in the infirmary.

Lunch and snacks are provided during on-site day camps. If your child has special dietary needs (e.g., Gluten-free, severe allergies, etc.) you can pack food to supplement their meals at camp. Please call or e-mail if you have dietary or medical questions.

CANTEEN: Forester campers may bank money (~\$4 per day, maximum \$20/week) to use at camp for snacks and drinks in the Canteen. You can put money in your camper account on CampWise or in person at check-in. Unspent funds can be donated to our summer mission project, campership fund, or will be returned at the end of the week.

Day camp families may purchase Sugar Creek apparel and other items for their campers at the Trading Post-Camp Store during camper departure times.

Get ready for a fun, faith-building adventure at Sugar Creek Bible Camp this summer!

Here is a faith practice idea you can do before camp: Pray for your camper as a family. Example: "Dear God, bless (*Camper's Name*) time at Sugar Creek. May (*name*) have an amazing week making new friends, exploring nature, and learning about You! Bless the other camps and counselors, may everyone have safe travels and be ready to make memories together. Amen"
