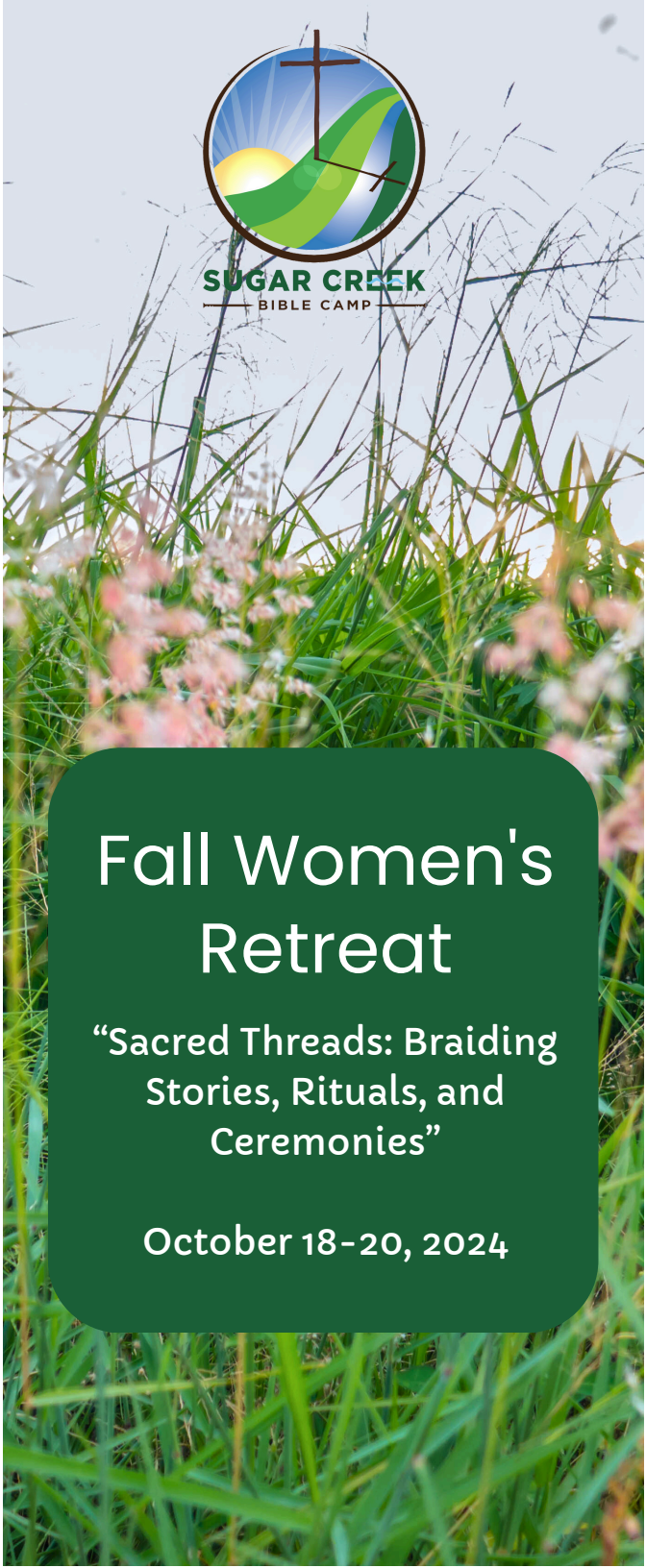
Open year-round, Sugar Creek hosts overnight events every weekend for individuals and groups. Interested in upcoming events or rental facilities?
