Hello Family Campers!

Thank you for registering for Family Camp. We look forward to having you join us for a fun, Christian family camp experience! Housing assignments are determined by any special needs, and then the order in which registrations were received, and your preferences.

Check-In begins at 5:00 PM with dinner served from 5-6:30. When you arrive at Sugar Creek, cross the bridge, drive ½ mile past the Retreat Center (RC), and park outside of the Manna Center (MC). Check-in will be on the MC patio (covered shelter) where you will receive a welcome packet including a schedule. Staff will collect any missing forms or fees at this time. Programming begins at 7 PM with a campfire devotion. Please let us know if you will arrive later than 7 PM.

Check-Out Family camp concludes at noon on your last day following brunch and closing worship. We ask that all families are out of their rooms before brunch. Families are welcome to hike or participate in outdoor recreation at camp following closing worship.

What should you bring?

- Weather-appropriate clothing and long pants for horseback riding
- Sleeping bag (or bedding) and pillows-please call about mattress sizes in your housing
- Swimwear
- Reusable water bottle
- Towels-bath, washcloth, and beach
- Sandals that attach to the foot for creek stomping
- Sturdy shoes or boots (closed toe, no Crocs) for horse/pony rides.
- Bible
- Flashlight
- Toiletries including sunscreen and bug spray
- Any medication, eye-care, or healthcare products you require
- Optional: camera, musical instruments, board and card games, bikes and helmets, etc.

Please Note: not all cell phones get reception at camp so plan accordingly. Camp phones are to be used only in case of emergency.

You are welcome to bring snacks along for your family; however, please consume your snacks in the dining areas, Manna Center decks, or covered pavilion, to keep cabins free from critters.

Canteen will be open during the afternoons for you to purchase snacks and drinks.

What should you leave at home?

Pets, firearms, fireworks, weapons, alcohol, and personal electronic devices. Due to liability and allergy situations, family campers may not bring animals to camp. The only exception is for certified, service animals. The camp must be notified of service animals in advance of your stay.

What will we be doing? Each day after breakfast there is morning worship, followed by Bible study and story time. Activities for children are led by our fun and caring Sugar Creek staff. Afternoons will be free for you to ride horses, swim, hike, go canoeing, make a craft, check out the Trading Post merchandise store, or relax as a family! Some activities are age or group-size limited (e.g., horseback riding, canoeing, or biking). Each evening, there will be fun games for youth and a campfire with devotions. All Family Campers can opt in or opt out of activities according to their comfort level and/or their interest.

Get ready for a fun, faith-building adventure at Sugar Creek Bible Camp this summer!
